To help prepare for the first weeks of school, please carefully review all of the materials included with this newsletter. **It is important that all medical forms, and the permission forms (for new students only) are returned by August 9th.** During the first week of school your children will wear name tags to help us get acquainted. Our staff wear name tags year round so you can identify us. Please remember to bring I.D. at pick-up time even if you're an "old timer" here, until our staff knows everyone. If your child will not be attending our school, please call and let us know. We may have other families who have been waiting for openings.

For the entire school year, half-day students should be dropped off at their classroom from 8:50 am to 9:00 am and picked up promptly from 11:50 am to 12:00 pm. If you arrive after 12:00 pm, all children will be waiting in their respective lunchrooms. Please be on time! We really do not want to enforce our late fee.

Each month we celebrate different Biblical themes, and for the month of September, our theme is **God Made All Things**. Not only will we learn how God made each of us incredibly unique, but we will see how in the beginning God made all of creation for His honor and glory. God is so creative! Key Fobs:

In an effort to ensure your child's safety, Joyful Noise has a security system. Each new family will be issued two key fobs. They will allow you access to our building during the time your child attends our program. DAYS –SEPARATION ANXIETY

If your child should experience separation anxiety, please know that this is completely normal and can come and go throughout the year. There are a few steps that you can take to help your child. Follow very similar routines each morning before you come to school. When you arrive at Joyful Noise, come to their classroom, sign them in and place their belongings in their cubby or on their hook. Take your child to a staff member, give them a big hug and kiss, confidently say, “I love you and I will see you in a while”, then quietly leave the classroom. Please know that it does take some children at least 6-8 weeks or more to gain trust in their new teachers and friends. Don’t be surprised if your child has struggles off and on during the year. Changes in their routine, lack of sleep or stressful situations may cause temporary anxiety. We will work through these rough times together and be assured, if we need your assistance,

we will be sure to contact you.
