Our hope is that you are already planning to join in the fun and excitement of our summer camp program. There are still a few openings if you would like to invite your friends, neighbors and maybe even your cousins to join in our fun!

During these long winter months, we have been hard at work planning our exciting summer camp full of fun for ages 2 1/2 –6 years old. Again this year we will divide our children into two groups, ages 2 1/2 thru 4 (Explorers) and ages 5 & 6 (Voyagers). Each week we will be celebrating a different theme such as Out of This World, Down on the Farm, Reptile Round-up, Master Chefs and Mad Science to name a few examples of past summers. The daily activities are quite different from the normal school year routine; however, they will still have circle time filled with Bible stories, music, snack, arts and crafts, science and social studies centers, play areas, games and outdoor play. We will be having all kinds of fun learning experiences with cooking, arts and crafts, games and so much more. Please spend a few minutes reading the following information about our summer camp and make note of what your child needs to bring each day.

Half day campers (9:00 AM -12:00 PM) - bring extra clothes in a zip-lock bag to be kept in their backpack in case of an accident and a water bottle, if desired, labeled with their name.

Extended half day campers (7:45 AM -12:45 PM) - bring extra clothes in a zip-lock bag to be kept in their backpack, a water bottle (labeled), and a lunch. (We do provide water or milk for lunchtime beverage if desired.)

Full day campers (6:45 AM -6:00 PM) - bring extra clothes in a zip-lock bag (to be kept at school), a book bag, a water bottle (labeled), a lunch (water/milk provided), a bathing suit for water play, a towel, water shoes, a plastic bag to send home their wet bathing suit/towel each day and fresh nap bedding each week for the children ages 2 1/2 through 4.

All campers - please sign your child in and out each day, label ALL their belongings and finally, make sure that you apply a long-lasting, high SPF waterproof sun screen to your child before coming to school each day.

Important Dates and Reminders

- **School is closed, Thursday, July 4th, Independence Day**
- Summer Birthdays: We would like to share your child’s birthday celebration. If you would like to send in a special snack, please speak with a staff member to make arrangements in advance.
- Socks and Sneakers are the safest footwear for your child to wear while at Summer Camp. Sandals can be slippery on the playground equipment and may make it difficult to run. Please provide water shoes for afternoon water play.
- Vacation Discount for all students: You may take one week vacation at no tuition charge and a second week at half tuition. (This must be taken in one full calendar week, Monday-Friday). There is no discount for subsequent weeks taken. You must complete a Vacation Notification Form and have it signed by Kathie or Laura to receive your discount.
- Withdrawal from the program: Please give two weeks written notice for your child’s early withdrawal from the program if leaving prior to 8/31. Any unpaid absence from the program beyond the time permitted by our vacation policy will require re-enrollment and the payment of corresponding registration fee to hold your child’s spot.
- Open House for Preschool & Kindergarten children attending this fall: Wednesday, August 28th from 6:00—7:00 p.m. Plan now to attend so you can meet your child’s new teachers and classmates. Please avoid bringing siblings as the classrooms become overcrowded quickly. Thank you for your understanding. Looking forward to seeing you soon!
